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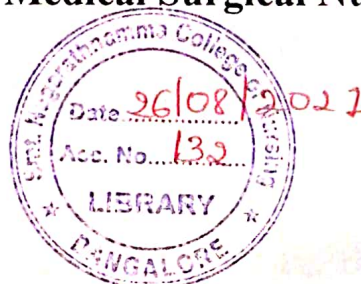
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ABSTRACT

BACKGROUND OF THE STUDY

Child sexual abuse is the involvement of a child in sexual activity that he or she does not fully comprehend, is unable to give informed consent to, or for which the child is not developmentally prepared and cannot give consent, or that violate the laws or social taboos of society. This study pointed towards understanding the attitude of staff nurses in caring of children with sexual abuse.

OBJECTIVES

- To assess the knowledge of staff nurses regarding child sexual abuse.
- To identify A Study to assess the attitude of staff nurses regarding Child Sexual Abuse, at selected Hospital, West Bengal.
- To provide trainings related to child abuse and prevention.
- To promote child abuse prevention awareness in the month of December.

METHODOLOGY

Descriptive approach, purposive sampling technique are used to collect data from 20 subjects. Selected by purposive sampling technique through *non probability* approach consisting of 2 sections.

SECTION-A:

Demographic Performa consisting of 9 items.

SECTION-B:

Likert's scale for assessing attitude level consisting of 16 items.

RESULTS

In the assessment the overall mean of attitude on knowledge score level was 73.5% and attitude on practice score level was 81% among 20 staff nurses were found to have adequate knowledge regarding child sexual abuse.
