 - Write a C program to compute simple interest. Draw the flowchart for the same. (06 Marks)
 - Evaluate the following expressions:
 - $2 * ((a \% 5) * (4 + (b - 3) / (c + 2)))$
where $a = 8$, $b = 15$ and $c = 4$
 - $a + = b * = c - = 5$
where $a = 3$, $b = 5$ and $c = 8$
 - $-100/20 < = 10 - 5 + 100 \% 10 - 20 = = 5 > 1 ! = 20$. (06 Marks)

- Convert the following mathematical expression into C expressions:
 - $s = \frac{a+b+c}{2}$
 - $\sin\left(\frac{b}{\sqrt{a^2+b^2}}\right)$
 - area = $\sqrt{s(s-a)(s-b)(s-c)}$
 - Write a C program to find the area of a rectangle. (06 Marks)
 - Classify the following as valid/invalid identifiers:
 - num2
 - \$num1
 - +add
 - a_2
 - sum, 1
 - for
 - num*
 - int(04 Marks)

- List any four differences between while loop and do-while loop along with syntax and example. (08 Marks)
 - Write a C program to find the roots of quadratic equation. (08 Marks)

- Write a C program to simulate the functions of a simple calculator using switch statement. (08 Marks)
 - Explain continue and break statement. (04 Marks)
 - Explain the formatted I/O functions of C language with syntax and example. (04 Marks)
