b. Sketch and explain the Ziggurat at Warka. (10 Marks)

- 6 a. Write short note on : i) Egyptian Mastabas ii) Egyptian pyramid. (10 Marks)
b. Explain with neat sketch the temple of Khons Karnak Erected by Egyptians. (10 Marks)

Module-4

- 7 a. Briefly explain the architectural features of Chinese civilization. (10 Marks)
b. Discuss the salient features of typical Chinese residence. (10 Marks)

OR

- 8 a. Explain the layout and construction of houses in the Japanese civilization. (15 Marks)
b. Write a short note on burial mounds of Japanese civilization. (05 Marks)

Module-5

- 9 a. Draw a neat sketch of the plan of pevsepolis and explain it in detail. (15 Marks)
b. Write note on Lion gate. (05 Marks)

OR

- 10 a. Briefly mention the cultural Background of Etruscan civilization and explain the Etruscan temple with a neat sketch. (10 Marks)
b. Sketch a typical vedic village showing the entrance gate and the cluster of dwellings and explain it. (10 Marks)
