ABSTRACT

Title- “A comparative study to assess the self-concept of 1st year and 4th year BSc nursing students at Smt. Nagarathamma college of nursing, Bangalore.”

Self-concept is defined as an individual’s perception of their identity and abilities, academic achievements and personal goal. This study explores the self-concept of first year and fourth year BSc nursing students, highlighting the difference and developments occur over the course of their academic journey.

BACKGROUND

Objectives:

- To Assess the level of self-Concept among the 1st year and 4th year BSc Nursing students.
- To compare the level of self-concept between 1st year and 4th year BSc nursing students.

Method:

A descriptive approach was used to collect the data from 50 subjects selected by simple random sampling technique (lottery method), the tool consisted of 2 sections.

Section A: Demographic variable consisting of 7 items

Section B: 15 MCQs to assess the knowledge of self-concept.

RESULT:

The majority of respondents who all are having adequate knowledge in self-concept belongs to 4th year BSc nursing (90%).

The overall percentage of knowledge score of 1st year BSc nursing is 63.33% and the overall percentage of 4th year BSc nursing is 90%.

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
